Estate: The Hähn family has winemaking tradition as far back as 1648, the winery has been in Kobern since 1892. Oenologist Konrad Hähn now continues this tradition and has achieved 2 national awards for excellence, is recommended every year by Feinschmecker Magazine and was among the Top 100 estates in 2004. The terroir is slate soil and all vines are planted on steep terraced slopes only.

Tasting note: Firm and focused, with peach and citrus notes matched to ample flesh in the middle. It's all nicely balanced, with a plenty of mineral on the lingering finish. Drink now through 2025.
