Estate: The Hähn family has winemaking tradition as far back as 1648, the winery has been in Kobern since 1892. Oenologist Konrad Hähn now continues this tradition and has achieved 2 national awards for excellence, is recommended every year by Feinschmecker Magazine and was among the Top 100 estates in 2004. He grows 95% Riesling and 5% Pinot Noir. The terroir is slate soil and all vines are planted on steep terraced slopes only.

Tasting note: This refreshing dry 100% Pinot Noir rosé is a perfect warm weather drink. Full of red fruit in the aroma, light mineral character on the palate and a refreshing finish.

Food affinity: Great to enjoy on its own, but also great with salads, picnic foods and at any warm weather day.
